The Town of Brighton is pleased to announce the launch of Monroe Community Power, a Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) program¹ that allows us to pool local electricity demand to provide low cost, **fixed-rate renewable electricity supply**. Brighton has selected Joule Community Power² as Program Administrator. Joule works on behalf of the municipality to secure clean energy supply at the most favorable terms, and ensures there are **no contract or exit fees** for consumers.

100% Renewable Electricity

The Monroe Community Power Program offers a 100% Renewable default electricity supply. Your electricity supply is matched by Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) provided by New York State renewable power plants (hydropower, wind, solar). **You will automatically be enrolled in the 100% Renewable option unless you opt out of the program before December 21st.**

Monroe Community Power Rates

Monroe Community Power has secured rates for your electricity supply that are lower than the historic, average RG&E supply rates by organizing a competitive bidding process among energy supply companies (ESCOs).

- **Source Power** will be your new supplier, beginning on your first meter-read date after January 1st, 2021.
- The new rate will remain fixed for a 24-month period through December 31st, 2022.

Residential / Small Commercial	\$.04299	\$0.04292

RG&E will continue to be responsible for the power lines that deliver your electricity and will continue to bill you. Please contact RG&E in the event of any service interruption.

Enrollment

If you wish to opt out of the program, please let us know by **December 21st, 2020**. If we do not hear from you, you will be enrolled, and your account data (including energy usage and utility assistance program participation status) will be shared with Source Power. However, you may still leave the program at any time without penalty. If you choose to remain in the program, your new rate will take effect beginning on your first meter-read date after January 1, 2021.
